Our school year is quickly drawing to a close, and we would like to give you an update on our teachers who will not be returning, or whose roles will be changing next year. We would also like to update you on the hiring process for new teachers for next year.

Staff Changes for Next Year:

The following teachers have decided not to return to Holy Trinity next year:

Mr. Joshua LaFond (Assistant Principal, Industrial Arts, Choir, Drama, Science 7)

Mrs. Robin LaFond (4th Grade, Math 7, Geometry, Algebra 2)

Mrs. Susan Steinke (Humane Letters 9-12, 4th Grade Grammar)

Joshua, Robin, and Susan are all excellent teachers, and they will be missed by our students and staff! We are grateful for their service. Please pray for them during this time of transition.

We are grateful that the following teachers will be returning to Holy Trinity next year, although with changes to their roles:

Mrs. Rhonda Houston will only be at school two days a week next year, so she will not be teaching upper-level art courses but will continue to do art instruction for grades K – 6.

Mrs. Sue Mielke will be stepping down as a classroom instructor (Band, Elementary Music) but will serve as our curriculum coordinator next year.

Mrs. Tina Scherer will be stepping down as a classroom instructor (PE, Math 6, Algebra) but will serve as library coordinator for next year.

Hiring for Next Year

God has blessed us with a number of qualified applicants for our open positions for next year. (For example, our high school humane letters position itself has attracted seven qualified applicants.) Interviews are continuing over the next week, and we hope to be able to announce the hiring of some new faculty members by the end of next week.
