(Amos Chalupsky, Entrepreneur)

Amos Joseph Chalupsky was a prolific entrepreneur and loving family man. Amos owned several businesses including a newspaper distributorship, oil distributorship, movie theater, on & off sale liquor stores in Nicollet, Montrose, Osseo, and St. Cloud; nursing homes in St. Cloud and Lake City, Fisherman's Point Resort, and Chalupsky's Lodge in Crosslake. He also owned several farms and investment properties around the state, and managed a private investment firm. Amos also authored a book, "The Self Made Entrepreneur" to help others learn and enjoy the great rewards of entrepreneurship.

Amos' family created the ACE Scholarship as a way for his family members to continue Amos' legacy of helping future entrepreneurs. As Amos was a tremendous supporter of Holy Trinity Catholic School, with great-grandchildren still attending the school, this scholarship is to provide tuition assistance for Holy Trinity High School students entering grades 7-12.

Each year, \$250 will be made available for tuition assistance scholarships. More may be available and will vary each year, as donations are made by other members and friends of the Chalupsky family.

The student candidate applying for this scholarship must be entering 7 - 12th grade at Holy Trinity in School and have a 3.0 GPA or better. In addition, the applicant should demonstrate good character at home, school, within the community and the parish and have a willingness to serve others. Priority will be given to students who have applied for tuition assistance.

All of the information requested on the attached sheet must be submitted, typed on a separate sheet, in order for you to be considered for this scholarship. No handwritten entries will be accepted. Upon completion, please submit your application to the high school office, attention Angie Hertel. A committee will be reviewing all applications.
