The high school, 7-12, will have conferences on Tuesday, November 13 only.

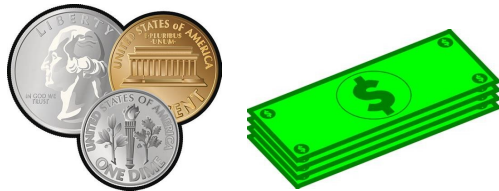
Conference times are 3:30—7:30pm both nights.
