Their first state game will be this Saturday, November 10th against Springfield. This game will be at 4:00pm at Shakopee West Junior High School.

Advanced ticket sales will take place this week at the Lester Prairie High School office until the end of the day on Thursday. Adults are \$11.00 and students K-12 are \$7.00.
