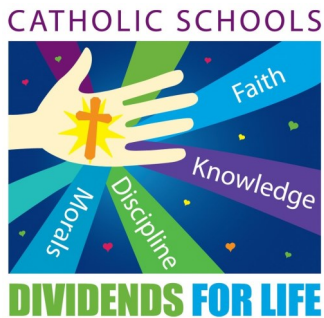
SOPHOMORE PANCAKE BREAKFAST
