LUNCH ACCOUNTS

This is a reminder to please check your family lunch account often. We really need to keep our lunch program in the black. Elementary lunch is \$2.75 and high school lunch is \$3.00, extra entrée is \$1.35 and soup is \$1.00 and \$.75, extra milk is \$.60. For one month of lunches with no extras it would be \$55.00 for ONE elementary student, and \$60.00 for ONE high school student. Keep this in mind when you send lunch money in.
