## ANGERMEYR BAND SCHOLARSHIP

William “Bill” Angermeyr had a deep love for music and believed that education is something you grab for, hang on to and nurture. Bill believed that with education comes dignity and honor, for yourself and others. Bill graduated from Morton High School in 1942. Following graduation from high school, he served in the United States Army and in, 1950, graduated from the University of Arizona with a degree in music education. During his time in Arizona, Bill played with the Tucson Symphony. He taught music education for two years in Litchfield Park, a suburb of Phoenix. Bill missed his native Minnesota and the family farm and in 1952 moved his family back to Morton to farm with his father and brother. Bill farmed for 42 years. He was a lifelong member of St. John’s Catholic Church in Morton, serving as a lay commentator, in the choir, on the Parish Council, and was currently a member of the finance council.

Bill Angermeyr was the grandfather of Holy Trinity students, Kelly, Kaitlyn and Kyle Jones and his family created the Angermeyr Band Scholarship as a way for his family members to continue Bill’s love of band and education. This scholarship is to provide tuition assistance for Holy Trinity High School students, entering grades 9-12, who are active in band at Holy Trinity HS.

Each year, a \$500 tuition assistance scholarship will be granted to two students who are active in band at HTHS. If you would like to make a donation to the Angermeyr Band Scholarship Fund, please note that with your donation.

The student candidate applying for this scholarship must be entering 9-12th grade at Holy Trinity School and must be active in band. In addition, the applicant should demonstrate good character at home, school, within the community and the parish and have a willingness to serve others.

All of the information requested on the attached sheet, must be submitted in order for you to be considered for this scholarship (no handwritten entries). Upon completion, please submit your application to the high school office, attention Angie Hertel. A committee will be reviewing all applications in a blind-review process.
